

# Read and Lunch Companions

## What to do:

- Arrive at 11:40 a.m. Sign in and get your volunteer lanyard and name tag.
- Go downstairs to Reeder Hall. Someone will help you get connected with a student and choose a book.
- Have the child read to you.
- Here are some suggestions



for you to use – as appropriate for the child you are working with:

- Usually the child will read to you. You might also take turns reading.
- Before reading – What do you think this book is about? What do you think might happen?
- During reading – What do you think will happen next? What makes you think that? What have you learned so far about \_\_\_\_\_?
- After reading – What did you like about this book? What other books are you reading?
- Stay through the lunch time to assist children while they eat.
  - Pack your own lunch. Please do not bring fast food or any beverage except water (no soda, iced tea, etc.).
  - Sit at a table with the children – 1 adult per table.
  - Talk to children and engage them in conversation.
  - Do your best to encourage children to eat the food they have before getting additional food.
